Biography

Marko Vladislavjević graduated from the Faculty of Economics in Belgrade in 2008 (Department: Statistics, Informatics and Quantitative Finance). He successfully defended his master thesis at the Faculty of Economics in Belgrade in 2011 (Department: Quantitative Analysis - Econometrics, mentor: prof. dr Aleksandra Nojković). From October 2014, he is enrolled in doctoral studies at the Faculty of Economics in Belgrade, Department of Statistics.

After completing undergraduate studies in 2008, Marko worked in Strategic Marketing (now IPSOS Strategic), as a researcher. From 2009 to 2011 Marko worked at the Faculty of Economics in Belgrade, on subjects "Economic statistics" and "Market Research", first as a student assistant (2009) and then as a teaching assistant (2010 and 2011).

From 2009 to 2012 he worked as a junior researcher at the Foundation for the Advancement of Economics (FREN). Since 2014 he is an independent (senior) researcher at FREN. Marko is one of the creators of the first Serbian micro-simulation tax-benefit model (SRMOD). Marko has worked as a consultant to the World Bank, International Labour Organization, UN Women and UNDP.

From February 2016, Marko works as a trainee-researcher at the Institute of Economic Sciences in Belgrade.
