- Abstract is to be written one line space from title in Times New Roman 11 pt, italic. 250 words is maximum.
- Key words comes under the Abstract with one line space.

Paper

- Paper is to be written in English
- Use Word for Windows
- Page Format B5, fully justified. Page Margine: 2,54 cm top, bottom, left, right
- Use font Times New Roman, 11 pt.
- Subtitles: centered, small letters, Times New Roman 12 pt, bold.
- Maximum number of pages 10 with space singl.
- Graphs are to be sent in format *cdr, jpg, gif* or *tif*.
